



PLAYGROUNDS

Dispersed Flexible Play

-large boulders and interpretative "cheese" walls have been placed outside of the designated play area. This will encourage other forms of play, utilizing all zones of the park

Junior + Senior Play

-junior play is completely enclosed by a custom wrought-iron fence + framed with a berm and planting, water-sand play, logs, a little hill and new toys.
-senior play is adjacent, enclosed but not fenced with some safety surface, some lawn.
-significantly enlarged senior play area with integrated opportunities for narrative, creative play - with a lookout area, climbing wall + rope bridge connecting to the Spacenet.

SKATING RINK

Natural Skating Rink + Tree Protection Rings

-gentle slope of open green space allows for easy flooding in the winter in order to create a natural skating rink
-tree protection rings were created to protect the existing trees from the flooding, allowing the skating area to expand past the trees
-two distinct skating environments are created - a quiet area around the trees for beginners, and an open skating area for more advanced play

Entries

-entries are simply access points framed by gently sculpted berm at SW corner adjacent to field seating curb and north berm that shelters play area

Main Plaza

-located south of the play area, surrounded by large boulders and trees, the main plaza will provide the community with a comfortable gathering space in the heart of Sibelius Square.

-The main plaza well-situated, close to the play area, the community garden beds, the rink and north of the central plaza, the area will act as meeting spot and a plaza for the community to interact.

Streets

-texturized/differentiated paving at intersections only
-crosswalks have been clearly marked
-seating nodes with a bench and planting have been located along the street
-tree planting on brunswick allee

Planting

-major street tree planting on brunswick allee
-ornamental shrub & perennial planting on new berm facing Bernard
-High canopy tree planting in/around plaza
-community gardens between brunswick and the new building

Building + Structures

-new building, now adjacent to play and at the north end of the park
-integrated shade structure, integrated into the rink

Landform

-sculpted play berms in jr and sr play areas

Furnishings

-recessed lighting in field seatwall
-replace floodlight for field
-bollard/post lighting in plaza
-new benches and picnic tables
